

**BOARD OF HEALTH
MINUTES OF MAY 6 , 2008**

The Tewksbury Township Board of Health met in regular session at 7:30 P.M. on the above date, in the Mountainville Meeting Hall, 60 Water Street, Mountainville, NJ. Chairman Peter Goyer presided.

Other members present were Shirley Czajkowski and Anthony Formica.

Janet Masterton, Anthony Miele and alternates Richard Mahevich and Zia Shey were excused.

1. Open Public Meetings Statement

The Open Public Meetings Statement was read by Mr. Goyer.

2. Action to be Taken

Block 37 Lot 3.04

Vincent Ruggiero of Apgar Associates was present to request a waiver from the Board for the above noted property. The percolation test results were one minute per inch, and the soil permeability class rating was K5. Mr. Ruggiero's design involves removing the existing soil in the zone of treatment and replacing with certified select fill as required by code. It was additionally noted that the system will have a two foot select fill envelope around the sides of the proposed bed.

Mr. Goyer made a motion to accept the proposed plan for Block 37, Lot 3.04 by adhering to the parameters as outlined in the letter from the Hunterdon County Department of Health dated 04/11/08, seconded by Mrs. Czajkowski. The motion was approved. Ayes: Czajkowski, Formica, Goyer. Nays: none. Absent: Masterton, Miele

Block 47 Lot 38

Wolfgang Wilhelm was present to request a waiver from the Board to only allow one percolation test for the property referenced above. The proposed plan as prepared by Steve Parker of Parker Engineering is a new system. Mr. Wilhelm presented a schematic soil log location map and soil test results as prepared by Mr. Parker. Soil tests were performed in March of 2008 and only one area was located with passing results. It was noted that the two acre property is located in an area of the Township with notably bad soils. Discussion followed regarding the location of the property on Matheson Road.

Mr. Goyer made a motion to accept only one passable percolation test for a primary field and not require a reserve septic field for the property located on Block 47, Lot 38 due to the size of the property and the condition of the soils, seconded by Mrs. Czajkowski. The motion was approved. Ayes: Czajkowski, Formica, Goyer. Nays: none. Absent: Masterton, Miele.

Block 47 Lot 30

Terrell Essig was present to request a waiver from the Board for a malfunctioning septic system located on the property referenced above. It was noted that two soil logs and a pit bail test were run for the reserve area, but the pit bail test was not considered "official" as it was run below the regional zone of saturation and did not have a one foot rise. Mr. Essig explained that during the test there was not sufficient water, but when the soil log was deepened there was more water and the permeability rate increased. He added that he was confident that if a reserve area were dug deeper, the test would yield

passing results. Discussion followed regarding the condition of the property and the location on the property that could serve as a reserve area.

Mr. Goyer made a motion to accept the reserve bed tests for the property located on Block 47, Lot 30 as presented with the condition that if a reserve field were needed, a re-testing of the soils would be done, seconded by Mrs. Czajkowski. The motion was approved. Ayes: Czajkowski, Formica, Goyer. Nays: none. Absent: Masterton, Miele.

It was noted that this matter is still before the Land Use Board and the comments heard at the March Board of Health meeting were shared with the Land Use Board.

Block 15 Lot 19 Cingular

It was noted that this application has been approved by the Land Use Board and did not require any input from the Board of Health.

Block 14 Lot 5 Burd

It was noted that this application is in front of the Land Use Board for lot coverage issues.
