

**Tewksbury Township Historic Preservation Commission  
Emergency Meeting Minutes

Wayne Lisa, the stone mason for the property owner, was present. Ezio Columbro had been to the Commission at the July 26, 2010 meeting to discuss replacement of the sidewalks on the church property. At the time, the Commission had concern on what material would be used along the Church Street side of the property. Mr. Lisa had brought samples to this meeting for the Commission to see and approve if it was acceptable. The sidewalks will be made of bluestone as shone with the sample provided and the new curbing would be granite as per the samples of the actual stone provided. A motion was made by Commissioner Beveridge seconded by Commissioner Melchiorre to approve the application as submitted. Of the four Commission members present, Commissioner Scheier, Commissioner Beveridge, Commissioner Young and Commissioner Melchiorre voted in favor of the motion.
