HUNTERDON COUNTY CONVERTS TO EVERBRIDGE TO RELIABLY DELIVER EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS TO RESIDENTS

New Citizen Web Portal Will Be Available To Register For Alerts

Using a customized opt-in portal powered by Everbridge, Hunterdon County residents and businesses will be able to sign up for personalized alerts on topics they care about, as well as provide additional contact information, such as mobile phone and unlisted numbers that are not included in traditional reverse 911 systems. "The self-registration portal is an important feature for the residents of Hunterdon" said Public Safety Director George F. Wagner, "Residents will be able to self-register unlisted numbers as well as cell phone numbers. Additionally, residents who do not live in the area can register the address of a relative or business. They will then be kept informed of events according to the address entered." Wagner said.
