

TEWKSBURY TOWNSHIP
Scenic Roads & Bridges Commission
Meeting Minutes
June 12, 2014 7:30 PM Mountainville

The June 12, 2014 meeting of the Scenic Roads and Bridges Commission was called to order by Chairman Harold Wrede at 7:40 PM. In addition to Chairman Wrede, SRBC members Barbara Todd, Hope Kaufman, Mary Fazzini and George Cassa were present.

A quorum was declared by Chairman Wrede, who then read the Open Public Meetings statement.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the May 8, 2014 meeting were reviewed and accepted as submitted.

Public Participation: No members of the public were present.

Discussion Items / Old Business:

- **Fox Hill Road Drainage Improvements:** Chairman Wrede reported that some of the plastic erosion matting that was no longer properly anchored has been removed. Chairman Wrede submitted a letter to the Township Committee expressing the SRBC's concerns with the substandard hydraulic performance of the recent drainage improvements.
- **LUB Application 13-02 – Cellco Partnership – Block 44, Lot 26, 19 King Street:** No additional materials were received from the LUB for review, and the SRBC took no action on the application.
- **LUB Application 14-03 – Sprint Spectrum, 24 Longview Road:** Cellular antenna co-located on existing JCP&L transmission tower, with equipment compound below: The SRBC had no comments or objections.
- **Stone Arch Bridges –**

The SRBC continued its discussion with Mr. David Townsley, who has volunteered his services to assist the SRBC in evaluating the possibility of preparing and submitting individual state and national historic register nominations for a bridge that has already been pre-qualified on the stone arch bridge Multiple Property Documentation Form that was prepared for Tewksbury in 2002. Mr. Townsley holds a Historic Preservation Certificate from Drew University. It was agreed that Mr. Townsley would investigate the available resources and necessary procedures and advise the SRBC as to the feasibility of pursuing a nomination for a single bridge as a test case, with as much of the effort supported by himself and the SRBC as possible.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 PM.
