

**TEWKSBURY TOWNSHIP**  
**Scenic Roads & Bridges Commission**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
**September 10, 2015      7:30 PM Mountainville**

The September 10, 2015 meeting of the Scenic Roads and Bridges Commission was called to order by Chairman Harold Wrede at 7:36 PM. In addition to Chairman Wrede, SRBC members Mary Fazzini, Hope Kaufman, Barbara Todd, Ulrich von Hollen, and George Cassa were present.

A quorum was declared by Chairman Wrede, who then read the Open Public Meetings statement.

**Approval of Minutes:** The minutes of the August 13, 2015 meeting were reviewed and accepted as submitted.

**Public Participation:** No members of the public were present.

**New Business:**

- LUB Application – Block 43, Lot 2.02, Vliettown Road: The application involved the addition of a pool house and access driveway as an accessory structure to the primary residence, which is presently under construction. The SRBC reviewed the application documents and determined that neither structure will be visible from Vliettown Road. Accordingly, the SRBC offered no comments on the application.
- Gates and Pillars – The SRBC reviewed photographs of gates and pillars installed at several locations on Homestead Road for the purpose of recommending possible standards for same. Hope\_Kaufman will investigate potential standards that may be in use in other jurisdictions.

**Old Business:**

- Stone Arch Bridges / Historic Register Project: The SRBC reviewed the results of Chairman Wrede's inspections of bridges that are presently not listed as eligible for preservation by the county. The SRBC will recommend to the Township Committee that the County should be requested to apply an equivalent (but informal) level of protection to the following additional bridges: T-7, T-10, T-22, T-30, T-35S, T-36, T-73, and T-91. Chairman Wrede will re-inspect bridge T-36 and certain bridges on Water Street to confirm locations and descriptions, which may be added to this list.

**Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 PM.
