The watershed area of Morris, Somerset, and Hunterdon counties may be eligible for cost share for conservation activities through the USDA-NRCS Environmental Quality Incentives Program and the NJWSA agricultural cost-share program.

These programs provide additional funding for projects implementing practices with a water quality benefit, including fencing livestock out of sensitive areas, cover crop, riparian buffers and other erosion, sediment and nutrient control practices.
